Cell phones, electronic games, and other non-AUSD issued electronic devices distract from the learning environment and are **not to be used or visible during instructional time**. This includes earpieces and phone devices worn around the neck. If a parent must reach a student during class, please contact the Attendance Office and we will get a message to the student.

Offense	Consequence
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student warned.</li> <li>• Discipline may occur.</li> </ul>
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electronic device confiscated by teacher and brought to the office on day of confiscation.</li> <li>• Student may pick up device at the end of the school day.</li> <li>• Discipline may occur.</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electronic device confiscated by teacher and brought to the office on day of confiscation.</li> <li>• Parent contacted with instructions to not allow student to have it on campus.</li> <li>• Parent must pick up electronic device.</li> <li>• Discipline may occur.</li> </ul>
Additional infractions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Will result in all of the above with possible loss of privileges and disciplinary consequences.</li> </ul>
